Full Subject Based Banding

Full Subject-Based Banding (Full SBB) is part of MOE's ongoing efforts **to nurture the joy of learning and develop multiple pathways to cater to the different strengths and interests of our students.**

With Full SBB, we are moving towards a secondary school education where students **learn each subject at the level that best caters to their overall strengths, interests and learning needs.**

Under Full SBB, there will no longer be separate Express, N(A), and N(T) streams, and **students will be in mixed form classes** where they can interact with peers of different strengths and interests.

The Progression Criteria

G1 students:

Pass in 2 subjects (one of which must be EL or Math)

G2 students:

- Pass in EL and 2 other subjects OR
- Pass in 4 subjects

G3 students:

- Pass in EL AND
- Pass in overall percentage of all subjects comb
